

The Procedure for Launching and Terminating Basic Study Programmes approved by SPbPU order dated 04.02.2021 No. 173

The procedure for launching and terminating basic study programmes determines a unified approach to making decisions about starting a new basic study programme of higher education – Bachelor’s, Specialist’s, Master’s study programmes (BSPs), including an international study programme (ISP), online study programmes, terminating BSPs in the federal state autonomous education institution of higher education “Peter the Great St. Petersburg Polytechnic University” (SPbPU).

The algorithm for launching and terminating BSPs is regulated by the following procedures:

- ✓ opening new BSPs – profiles within the framework of licensed Bachelor’s, Master’s majors and licensed specialities within Specialist’s programmes;

- ✓ opening new forms of education within the existing BSPs;
- ✓ changing BSP title with no changes in its content;
- ✓ launching international study programmes, online study programmes within the framework of licensed majors;

- ✓ licensing new majors;

- ✓ terminating BSPs.

Launching and terminating BSPs, changing their titles with no changes in their content take place by the decision of SPbPU Academic Council.

Every procedure of BSP launching and terminating requires a list of documents which have to be submitted to the Centre of Study Programme Development at the Directorate of Basic Study Programmes.
